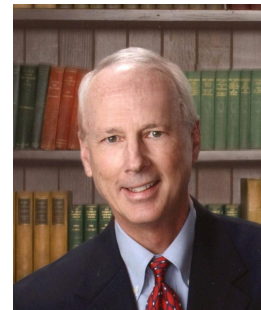

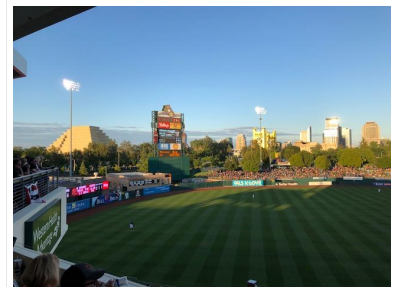


## Event Recap: Family Night at the River Cats
